ABOUT BLOCK NINE

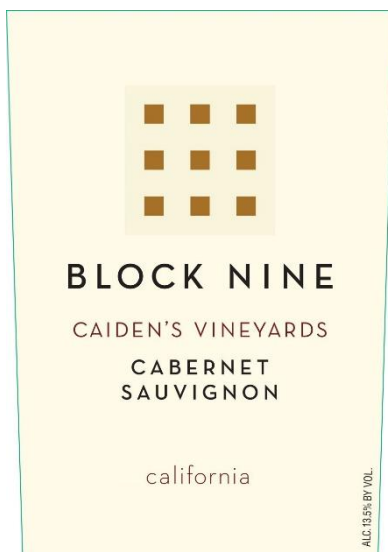

Consumers were left with fewer choices of smaller production, family-owned wines. After years of making only Pinot Noir with consistently high ratings, we expanded our product offering to include this great value Cabernet Sauvignon.

WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

The 2024 Block Nine Cabernet Sauvignon exhibit aromas that gush of warm plum and blackberry fruit flavors. This wine is well built up front with flavors of black currant fruit, cassis and hints of sweet spice. It shows good energy as licorice and apple wood accents complete its complex finish. The 2024 growing season was generous in length and consistent temperatures. Flavors were strong at harvest and we think 2024 will prove to be a terrific vintage.

After completing his Enology degree at UC Davis, Larry spent seventeen years at Dry Creek Vineyard. He has since covered the globe by making wine in New Zealand, Chile, and Australia.
